



A Case of Rare Aniridia in a Patient who Underwent Intraocular Lens Exchange

A patient who underwent intraocular lens (IOL) exchange and did not report any trauma presented with total aniridia, or missing iris, and vitreous hemorrhage two months after the procedure




What are the possible explanations for uprooted and missing iris?


Patient who underwent IOL exchange



Probable mechanisms of postoperative aniridia



Distortion of cataract incision causing leak



Iridodialysis from possible trauma when patient was unaware

Mild blunt trauma, which the patient was unaware of, following the fresh IOL reimplantation surgery is most likely to be the cause of 8-ball hyphema and missing iris
