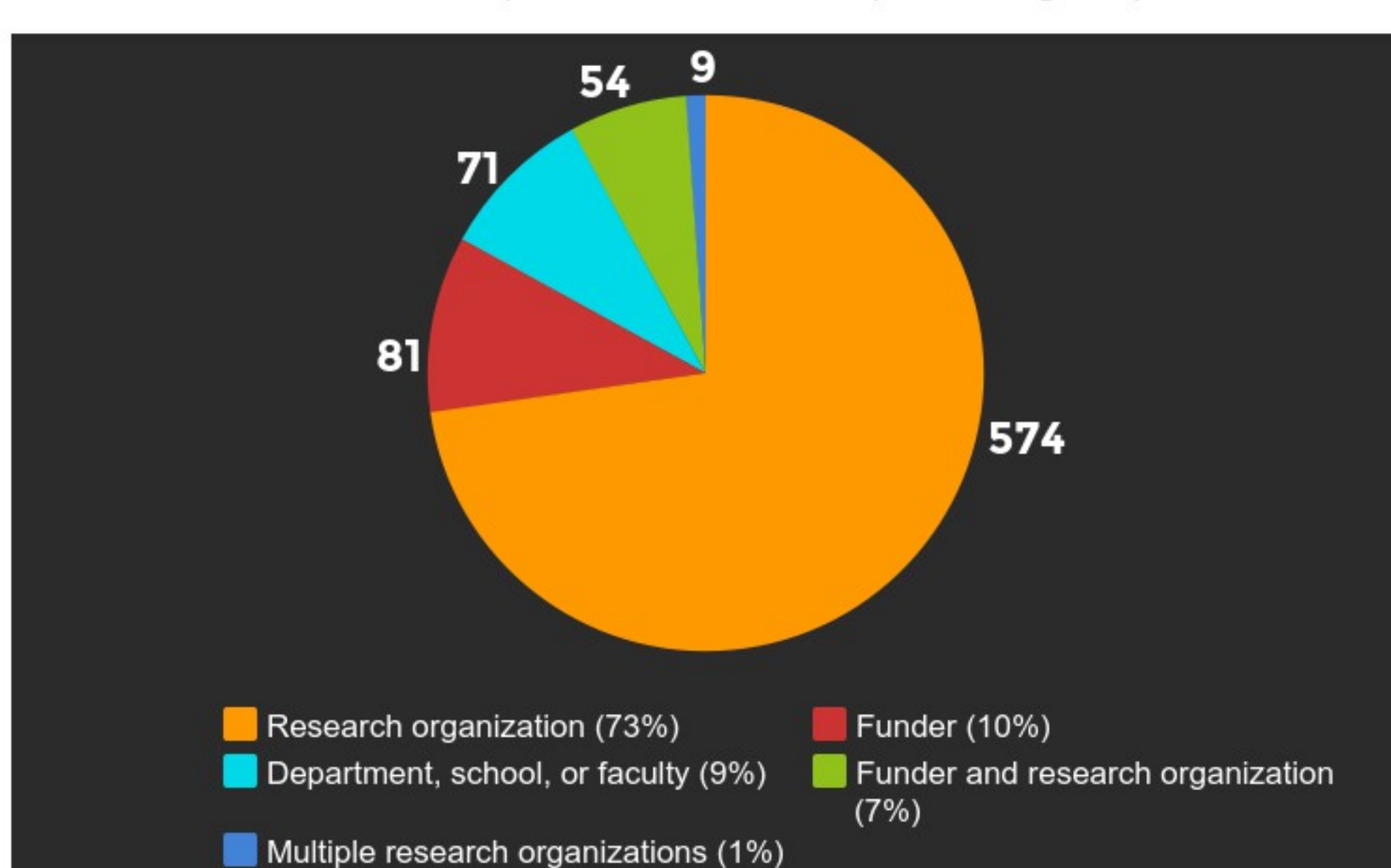

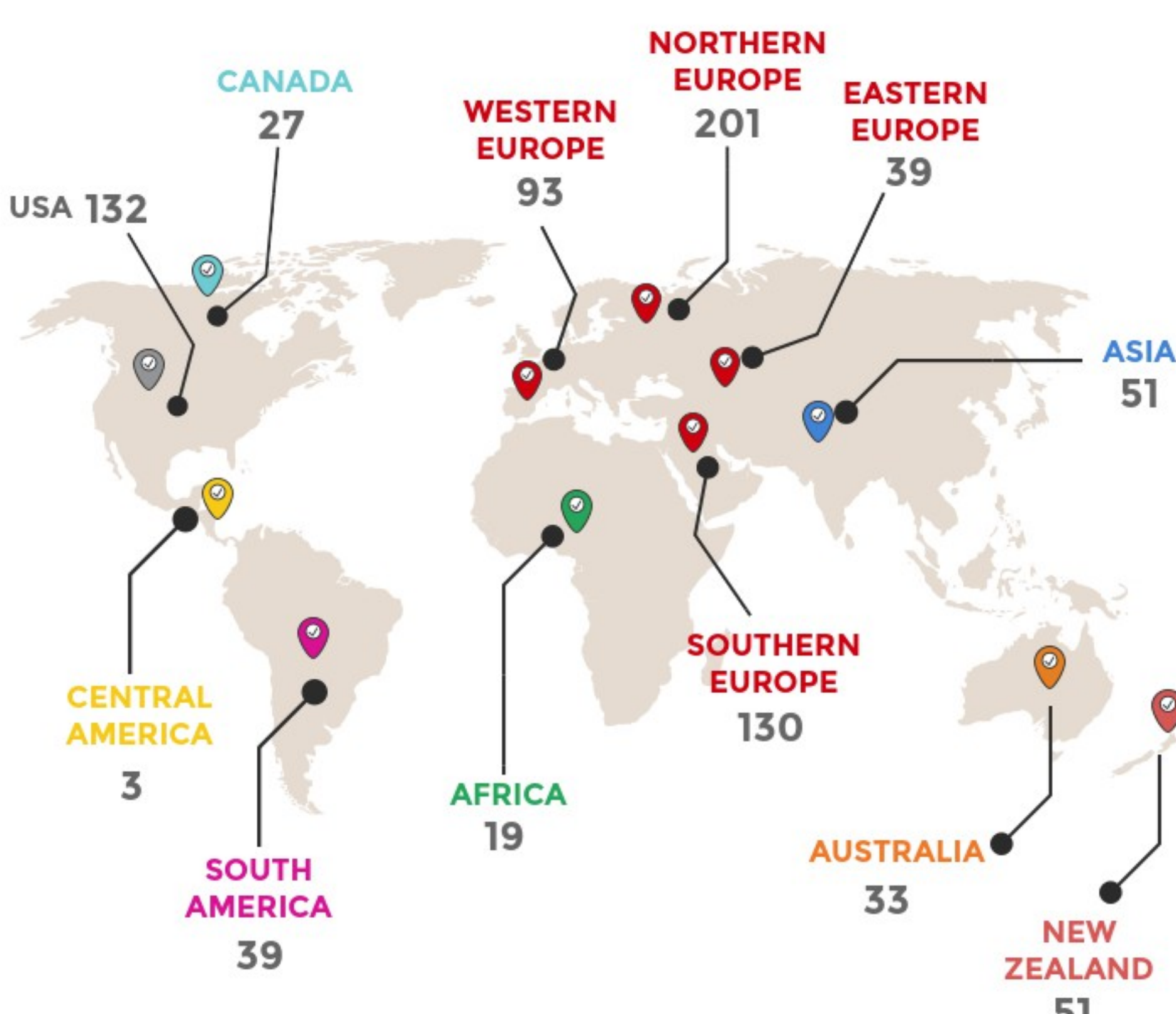
OA policies and mandates by type

The number of policies and mandates implemented globally



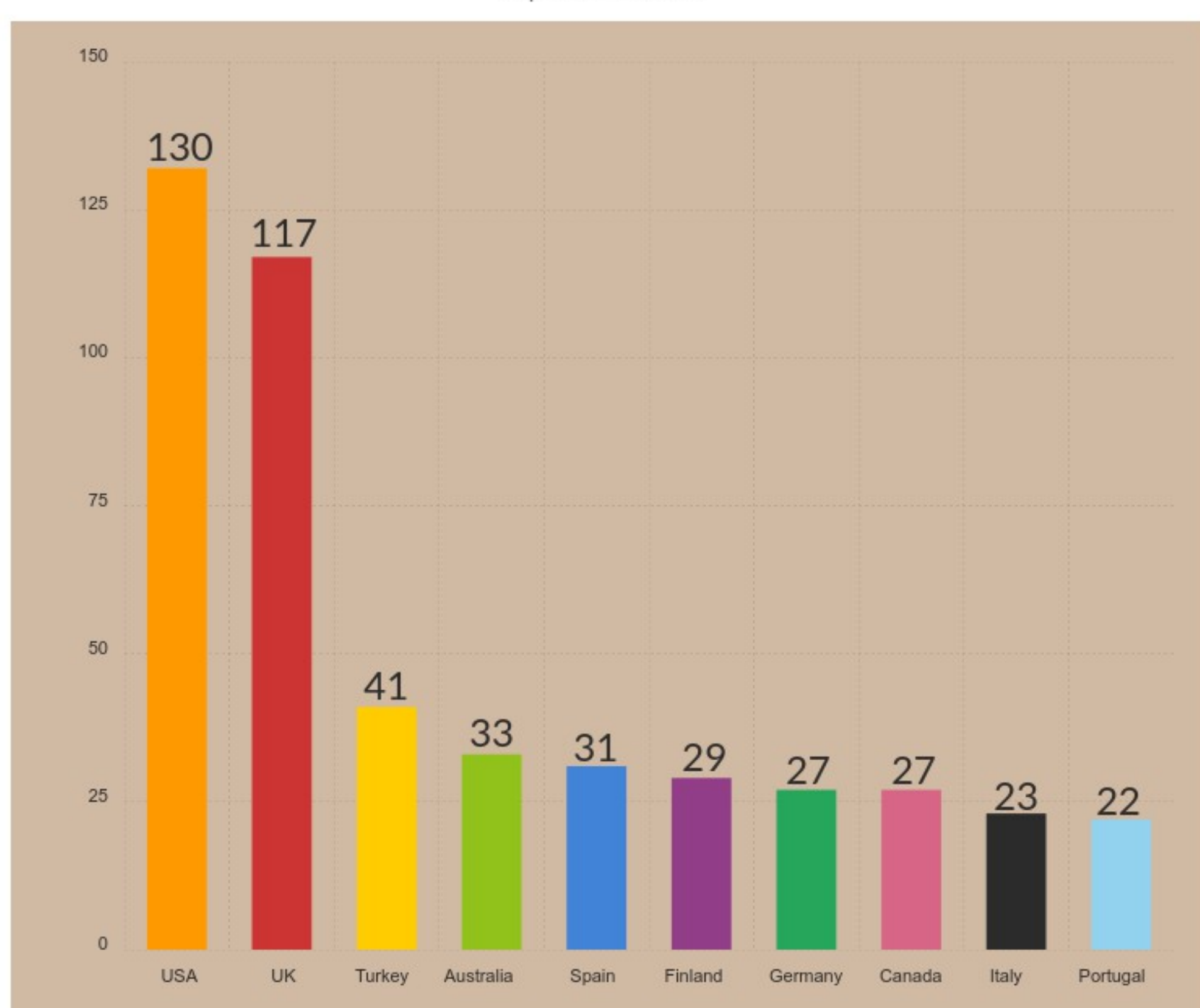
OA policies and mandates across the globe

A representation of the number of open access policies and mandates by continental region



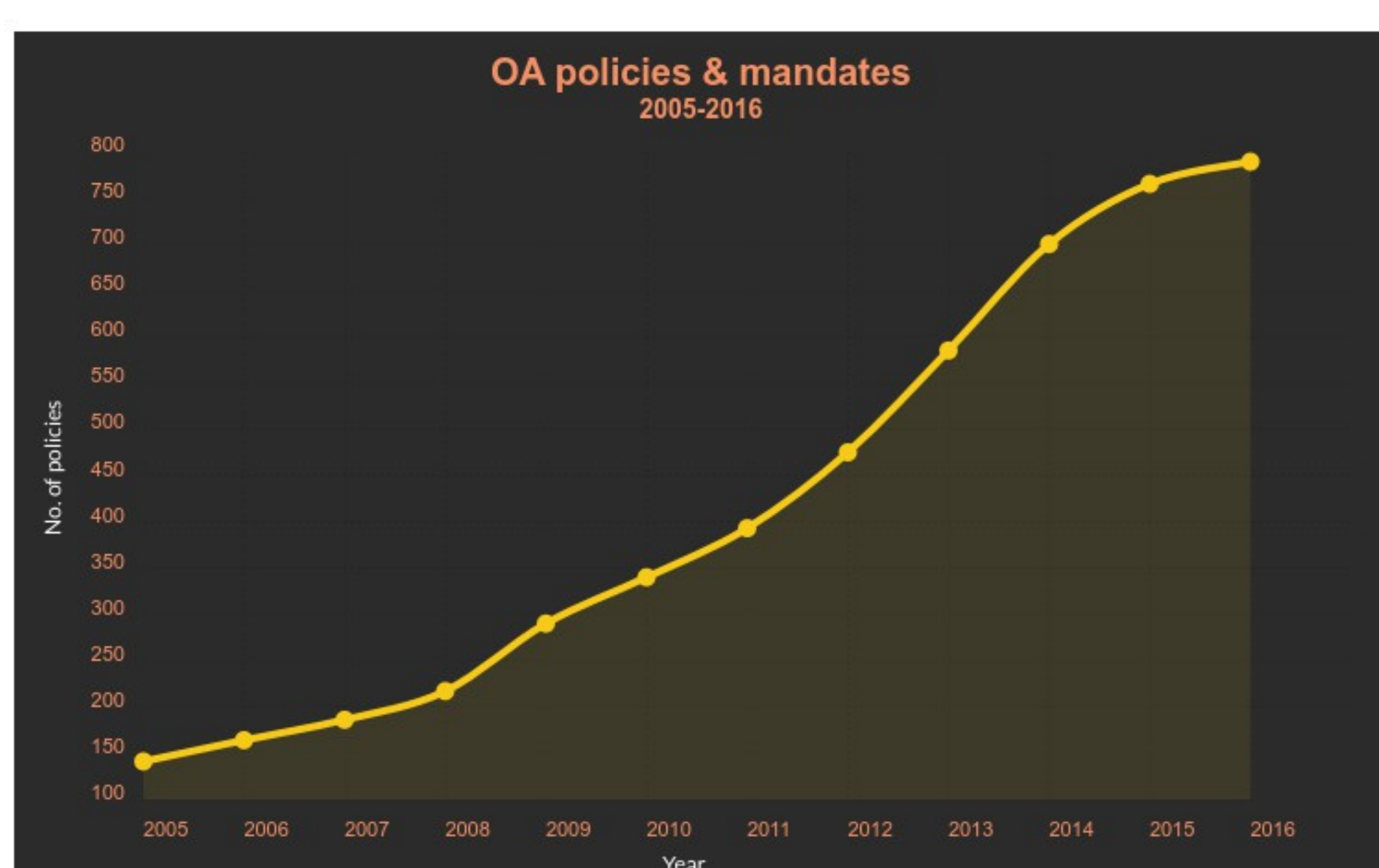
Countries with most OA policies and mandates
